Background and Expertise

Please briefly present the organisation (e.g. its type, scope of work, areas of activity and if applicable, approximate number of paid/unpaid staff, learners)

AKMI Katartisi was established in 2000 and was certified as a Level 2 National Centre for Vocational Training (K.D.V.M.2) by the National Organization for the Certification of Qualifications and Vocational Guidance (EOPPEP). It has more than 25 years of experience in the field of Vocational Education and Training and Lifelong Learning, focusing on pioneering learning methodologies/activities and having presence in Athens and Thessaloniki. So far, more than 20.000 individuals have been enrolled and benefitted from classes in various fields. Its private facilities have received 1 million euros in investments for state-of-the-art infrastructure and equipment. It includes learners who are from different socioeconomic backgrounds, including vulnerable groups with cultural backgrounds, migrants, people living in marginalized areas, long-term unemployed etc.

AKMI Katartisi has participated in various European Projects that are funded by the EU. Specifically, they have experience as partners in AMIF and Erasmus+ projects (KA2 Strategic Partnerships for VET).
